Bowlers of all averages are invited to enter to represent Victoria in an exciting competition between Victoria, Queensland and New South Wales to be held at Oz Tenpin Epping, Victoria Tenpin Australia Championships from Friday 27<sup>th</sup> September and East Coast Challenge Cup from Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> October 2019

### **Eligibility**

This Tournament is open to all 2019 Tenpin Bowling Australia Registered Bowlers residing in Victoria (including Albury). Bowlers must be registered as at 30<sup>th</sup> April 2019. Bowlers are required to complete no less than 18 games in a league as at 31<sup>st</sup> May 2019, and continue to bowl in a registered league up to the commencement of the ECCC tournament. Bowlers not meeting these requirements **MUST** send a letter detailing reasons with the entry form to the United Tenpin Bowling Association office. Acceptance of any entry and confirmation of the average will be determined by UTBA Board.

### **Format**

**Stage 1** - UTBA CHAMPIONSHIPS

First Appearance in each of Singles, Doubles and Teams (All Events) will count towards the first stage of the ECCC roll off.

**Stage 2** - All bowlers will bowl 8 games in their allocated squads.

**Adult Male** - At the completion of all stages the top 7 scratch scores will be declared the Open team. The remaining bowlers will have their handicaps added and the top 7 will be declared the Graded team.

**Adult Female** - At the completion of all stages the top 7 scratch scores will be declared the Open team. The remaining bowlers will have their handicaps added and the top 7 will be declared the Graded team.

**Under 21 Boys & Girls** - At the completion of all stages the top 3 scratch Males and 3 Females scores will be declared the Open team. The remaining bowlers will have their handicaps added and the top 3 Males and 3 Females will be declared the Graded team.

**Senior Male and Female** - At the completion of all stages the top 7 scores **WITH** handicap will be declared the Senior Male and Female teams.

### **Team Members**

Each team member will receive 1 Team Shirt, 3 entries (1 x Singles, 1 x Doubles & 1 x Teams) into the Tenpin Australia Championships **plus** All Events Entry. This **includes** 3 Masters qualifying attempts and includes any/all games in the East Coast Challenge Cup.

**All Team members must be available to bowl on the Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> Sept and Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> Sept of the Tenpin Australia Championships.**

**Failure to complete your allocated 9 championship games by the commencement of the ECCC tournament will result in your immediate removal from the team.**

**Tenpin Australia Masters** - The top qualifiers in all divisions will represent the United Tenpin Bowling Association in the Tenpin Australia Masters stage 1 qualifying. At bowlers own cost.

### **TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS**

1. This Tournament is open to all 2019 Tenpin Bowling Australia Registered Bowlers residing in Victoria (including Albury). Bowlers must be TBA registered as at 30<sup>th</sup> April 2019. All TBA Tournament Rules & Regulations will apply.
2. Bowlers must be part of and continue to bowl in a registered league until the completion of ECCC 2019.
3. The highest league average (over a minimum of 18 games) as at 31<sup>st</sup> May will be used. Handicap will be **100% of 210**.
4. Age Restrictions - As at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019,  
\*\*\* 'Under 21' bowlers must be under the age of 21.  
\*\*\* 'Senior' bowlers must be 50 years of age or older.
5. **DRESS CODE:** Suitable neat attire is required during all sessions of the roll-offs. Collared shirts, trousers/skirts or dress shorts (**no cargo, no denim & no leggings or active wear**).
6. All bowlers will be required to read and sign the Code of Conduct prior to the commencement of the UTBA Championships.
7. No smoking will be permitted during the tournament.
8. Unsporting conduct will not be tolerated.
9. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to check a bowler's equipment at any time during any stage of the roll off.
10. League verification sheet must be submitted by **the first roll off (1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2019)** If not submitted by this date an average of 200 will apply until this is completed. If the average is found to be higher after checking, then the checked average will be increased by 10 pins for handicapping purposes. Failure to disclose a league could result in your entry being refused.
11. Any tie for first or seventh place (or 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each gender in the Under 21 division), will be decided by a one game roll off.
12. **The United Tenpin Bowling Association Committee reserves the right to re-average any bowler.**
13. Any matters not covered on this entry form shall be subject to the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
